



Madrasah Guidelines Document

Checklist for attending Madrasah

1. Perform Wudu or Ghusl (shower) before coming to Madrasah
2. Wear clean clothing (especially clean socks) and clothing should not smell of food
3. Shirts should be long enough to cover mid thigh (Abaya preferable)
4. Clothing that is sheer and tight is not recommended for Madrasah
5. Girls should wear a Hijab and boys should wear a Kufi (topee)
6. When you come to the Masjid, **YOU MUST** put your shoes on the racks. Shoes should not be left on the floor.
7. Obey all signs and it is your duty to keep the Masjid clean

Using the Washroom while attending Madrasah

1. Always ask permission from your teacher
2. Wear the slippers and enter the washroom with your left foot first
3. Make sure you have to wash yourself before sitting on the toilet
4. After you have used the room, check to make sure that is clean for the next person to use
5. Wash your hands with soap
6. Perform your Wudu again and return to your class

During the class

1. Obey the teacher at all times.
2. Talking is not allowed during the class
3. Cell phones or electronics (tablets, etc.) are not to be used during the class
4. Permission must be obtained from the teacher if you need to use the Masjid phone
5. If you have a medical problem and need to use the washroom often, parents should advise the teacher of this condition
6. If being picked up early (before the class ends), the parent should pick up the children from their respective class(es). Waiting inside by the doors or outside the building is not allowed

At the end of the class

1. Parents must pick up the children from inside the Masjid
2. No waiting or playing is allowed outside of the Masjid
