

## Mosque Capacity Based on the Province "Phased" Strategy

The **target is 250 congregants**

Before heading out to the Mosque, you must review the "**rules and guidelines**" procedures to first determine if you are eligible to attend the Jumuaah prayers. You will then be required to complete a registration, which is mandatory. The registration form can be filled out "online", but you also have the option of printing the enclosed registration, filling it out and bringing it with you.

### Rules and Guidelines

#### Rules

1. You must be between the ages of 14 to 70.
2. You must wear a "mask" before approaching the Mosque and keep the "mask" until you leave the Mosque.
3. You must perform "wudu" at home.
4. You must bring a "plastic" bag to keep your shoes in.
5. **Do not bring a prayer rug.** You will be provided with something for your sujood.
6. A registration form must be completed to attend the Jumuaah Prayer. See link on web page for "**Registration Form**".

#### Guidelines

1. The doors will open at the Mosque at **12:15pm and 2:30pm** on **Fridays**
2. Washroom facilities will be closed.
3. Water stations will closed.
4. **Social distancing will be strictly enforced.**
5. You will be provided with hand sanitizers on entering and exiting the Mosque.
6. You must follow the instructions of the volunteers.
7. There will be no praying of "sunnahs" at the Mosque and we ask that you complete your "sunnah" prayers on return to your residence.

#### Miscellaneous items

1. It is incumbent on each person to look at the weather condition for the day. There are no provisions available at the Mosque and we cannot provide such provisions due to the "social distancing" rules, therefore, if the weather is suspect, please consider staying home.
